2ND ANNUAL PANFISH ICE FISHING TOURNAMENT

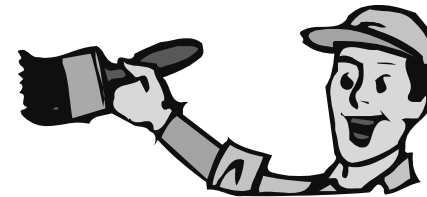
It is once again time for our annual St. Paul's Ice Fishing Tournament. Bring your baith, poles and a lot of hot chocolate for a day of fun and fishing.
